## A Brief History of Myrtle Beach

History records that the first visitors here were Spaniards from Hispaniola under the command of Lucas Vasques de Allyn. His small party landed in 1526 about 50 miles north of present-day Myrtle Beach and eventually established the first European settlement in America about 30 miles to the south. However, that settlement, San Miguel de Gualdape, was abandoned the following year and the group returned to Hispaniola.

Over the next 300 years, the region's population grew very slowly. Around 1900, people began to "vacation" here, although it was quite rustic. Houses and camps were sparse, and there were few permanent residents in those early years. Drawn by the ocean and the area's appealing subtropical climate, people began to call Myrtle Beach "home" as the century progressed.

Named for the fragrant Wax Myrtle shrub that grows so abundantly throughout the area, Myrtle Beach was incorporated as a town in 1938 and became a city in 1957. It is the heart of South Carolina's Grand Strand, a 60-mile stretch of beach communities along the state's northern coast that welcomes more than 13 million visitors annually. According to the latest census, it is also among the fastest growing metropolitan areas in the nation.

Of course, the Atlantic with its clean, wide beaches is the number one attraction and the reason why so many are lured to Myrtle Beach year after year. The area also offers a wealth of recreational, entertainment, dining, shopping and other fun-filled opportunities to please just about anyone. From outstanding family attractions and live entertainment theaters to world-class golf, it's the ultimate family and group vacation destination.

# PHONE/INTERNET

## *Dialing Instructions*

### **Room to Room**

For the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> floor rooms or adjoining suites, please call the operator for assistance. **For all other rooms, please dial 1 plus the room number.**

### **Local Calls**

To place a local call dial 9, and then dial the local area code and number.

### **Long Distance Calls**

To place a direct-dialed, long distance call, dial 9 + 1, the area code and the phone number.

### **International Calls**

Dial 9, then 011, the country code, the city code, and the local number.

### **Operator Assisted Long Distance Calls**

Dial 9, then 0, the area code and then the phone number. Use this feature for credit card, collect, person-to-person, and any third-party calls. An operator will offer assistance and also instructions before your call is completed.

### **Operator Assisted International Call**

Touch 9, touch 0, the country code, the city and then the local number. An operator will intervene to receive your instructions for this operator-assisted call.

### **Do Not Disturb**

If you wish not to receive incoming phone calls to your guest room, please contact the hotel operator by pressing 0 on your telephone and request "Do Not Disturb" service.

### **Messages**

Press the **Voicemail** button on your room phone to retrieve messages or dial **3090** for messages.

#### **For Windows Users**

# FOR YOUR SAFETY

## *FIRE SAFETY*

In case of fire in the Marina Inn, please remain calm.

Notify hotel security immediately by calling **0 or 911** and, if possible, activate the nearest pull station. Please do not assume that someone else has reported the fire.

If your room is smoky, take your key, get on your hands and knees (or stomach) and crawl to the door. Touch the doorknob; if it is hot, do not open the door. If the doorknob is cool, open the door slowly. If the hallway is smoky, stay next to the wall and crawl toward the nearest staircase. Never use an elevator and do not prop open the doors to the staircase. Hang on to the handrail and walk down the exit staircase. Please do not let go of the handrail.

If you are unable to leave your room, call the reception desk and let them know your location. Fill your bathtub with water, wet some towels and place them at the bottom of the entry door. Use your ice bucket to bail water if you are exposed to flames.

Check for smoke outside of your window. If there is no smoke present, open your window and hang a sheet from outside the window to make your location visible to rescue personnel.

If your room becomes unbearable, you may be forced to choose the best exit, whether it is your window or a stairwell. Remember to keep low and move carefully.

**For your protection, this building has the following:**

- Take your key with you when you exit your accommodations

In the event of severe weather, please stay tuned to local radio and television stations for the latest updated information. If you remain in the area, you are advised to be prepared for a mandatory evacuation if conditions worsen. If an evacuation is ordered, all persons must leave the area.

# CONDO FIREPLACE LIGHTING

**WARNING: DO NOT attempt to light any fireplace in a unit that has the odor of gas.**

**CAUTION: The fireplace screens become very hot during fireplace operations and touching them should be avoided.**

Please use the following procedure to light and enjoy the fireplace

1. Verify that the three position rocker switch is in the off (middle) position
2. Rotate the pilot/off/on knob into the pilot position
3. Push and hold in the pilot/off/on knob while in the pilot position
4. Wait approximately 15 seconds and press the igniter button
5. Pilot light glow should be visible behind the front full log right side
6. If pilot light does not light, wait another 15 seconds then press the igniter button again
7. Check for pilot light flame
8. If after repeated attempts to light the pilot light you do not succeed and begin to smell gas stop pressing the igniter and holding the pilot/off/on knob. Ventilate the room immediately before returning to step 5
9. Once you have successfully lit the pilot light flame, continue to hold the pilot/off/on knob in the pressed in position for at least 1 minute
10. Then release the quickly rotate the pilot/off/on knob to the on position
11. Flip the rocker switch into the ON position and within 1 minute the burners should light
12. If the burner does not light and/or you smell gas, turn the pilot/off/on knob to OFF and ventilate the room and contact the front desk for assistance
